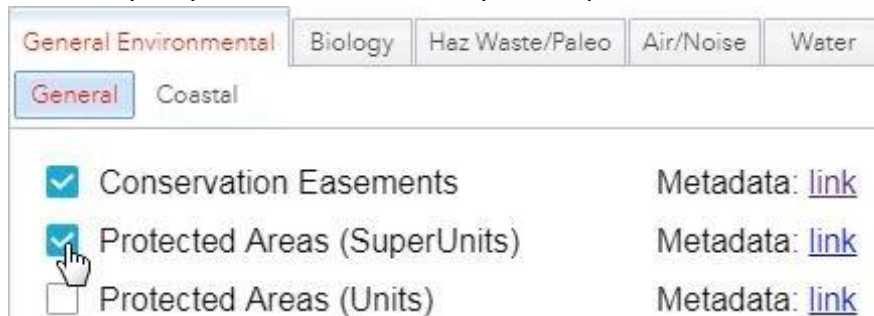


Print Plus

The purpose of this tutorial is to demonstrate the functionality of the **Print Plus** widget. The Print Plus widget allows you to specify an area to print, create map documents, and print to different formats and sizes.

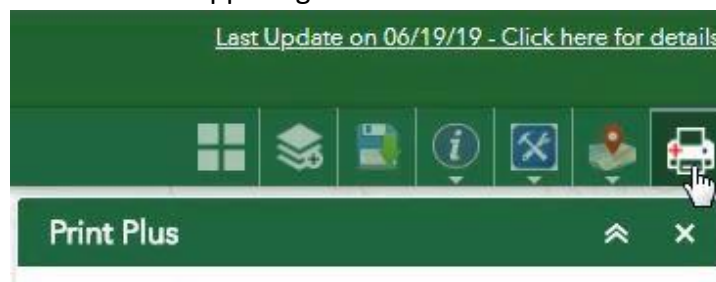
1. First, activate the layers you wish to include in your map.



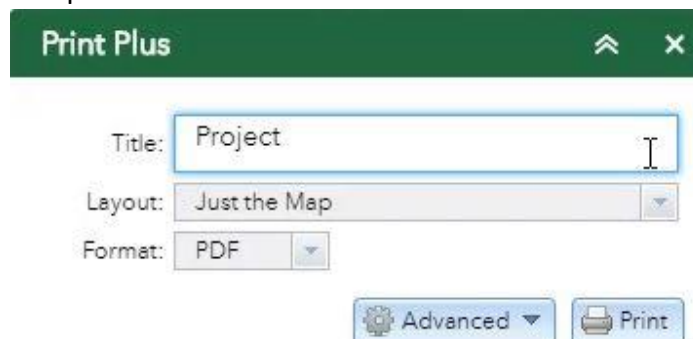
2. Zoom in to your area of interest.



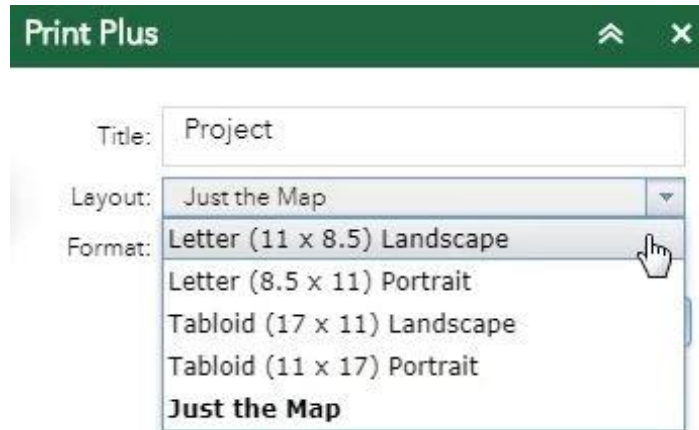
3. Click on the printer icon in the upper right-hand corner.



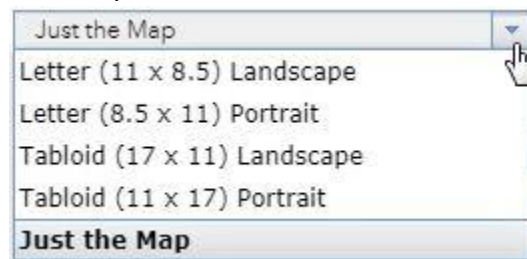
4. Add a title to your map.



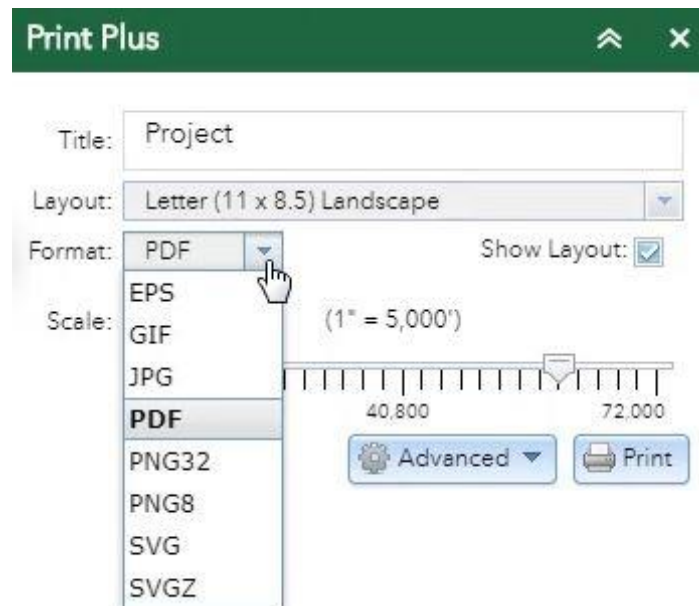
5. Choose a layout.



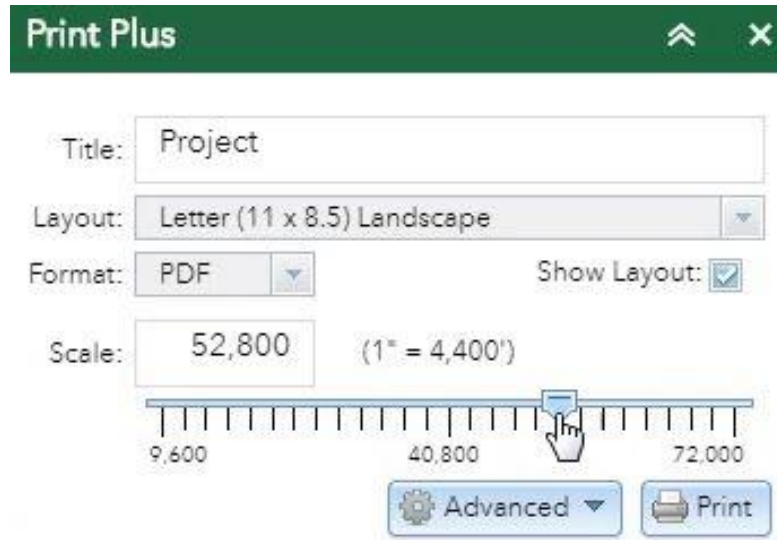
Note: 'Just the Map' will print only the map, omitting any marginal information (title, legend, scale, etc.) from the output.



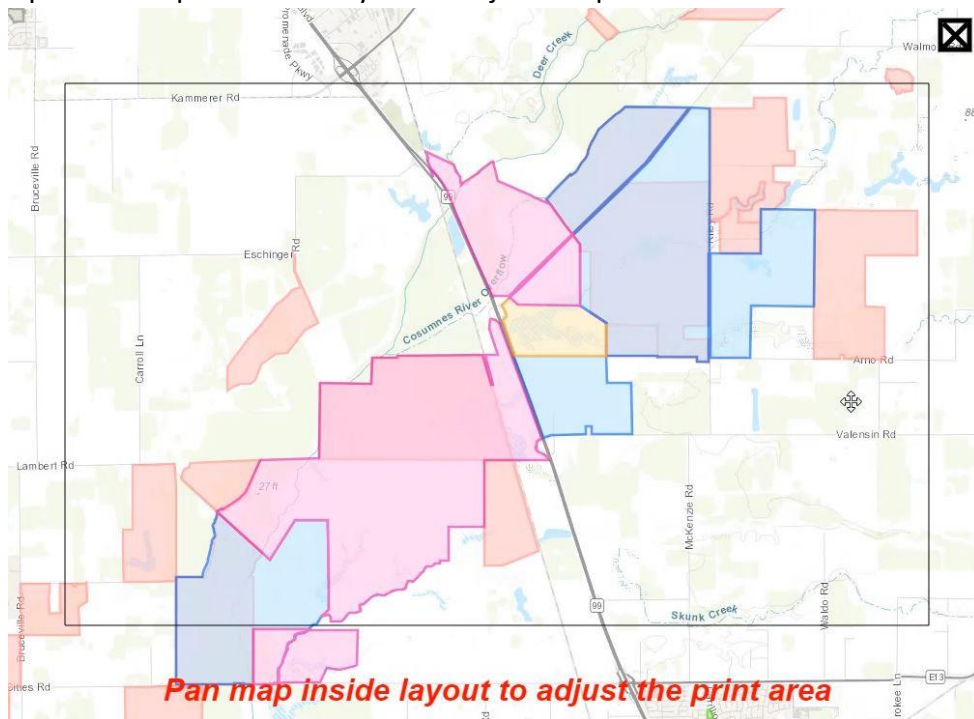
6. Choose a format.



7. You can adjust the scale.



8. You can pan the map inside the layout to adjust the print area.



9. From the advanced settings you can adjust the resolution, add your name as the author, and add copyright.

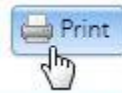

10. When you're ready to create the map document, click Print.



11. Click on the document to open it.



12. Click the download icon in the upper right-hand corner to download the document.
