

Water Quality Planning Tool; 303(d) List Legend


The water bodies on the 303(d) list are shown as blue lines and polygons. To best see them turn on the satellite imagery (top right of the map).

The rivers, stream, creeks, lakes, ponds, etc. on the list may be shown in a variety of ways. Long water bodies like rivers and streams may be shown as a single line representing the center line of the waterway or as two lines representing the banks. Lakes, ponds, and similar features may be shown as either a filled-in polygon or an empty polygon. See the examples below.
