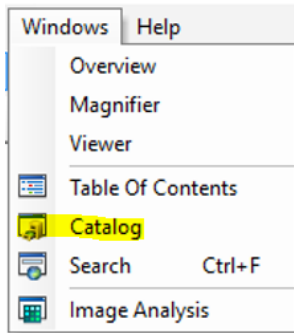
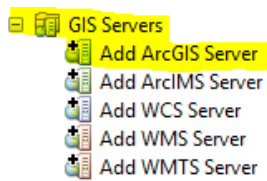


## How to download layers from the GIS Library

1. You can access the layers through ArcMap, open the software and under “Windows”, select “Catalog”

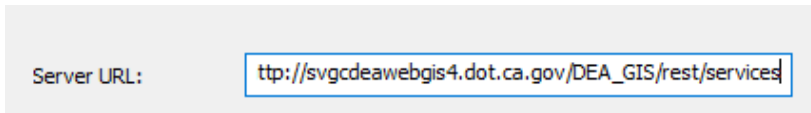


2. Scroll down and under “GIS Servers”, select “+Add ArcGIS Server”

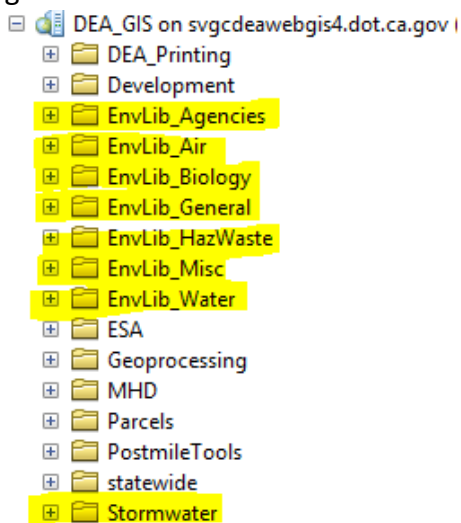



3. Select “Use GIS Services”
4. Add the following URL to the “Server URL”

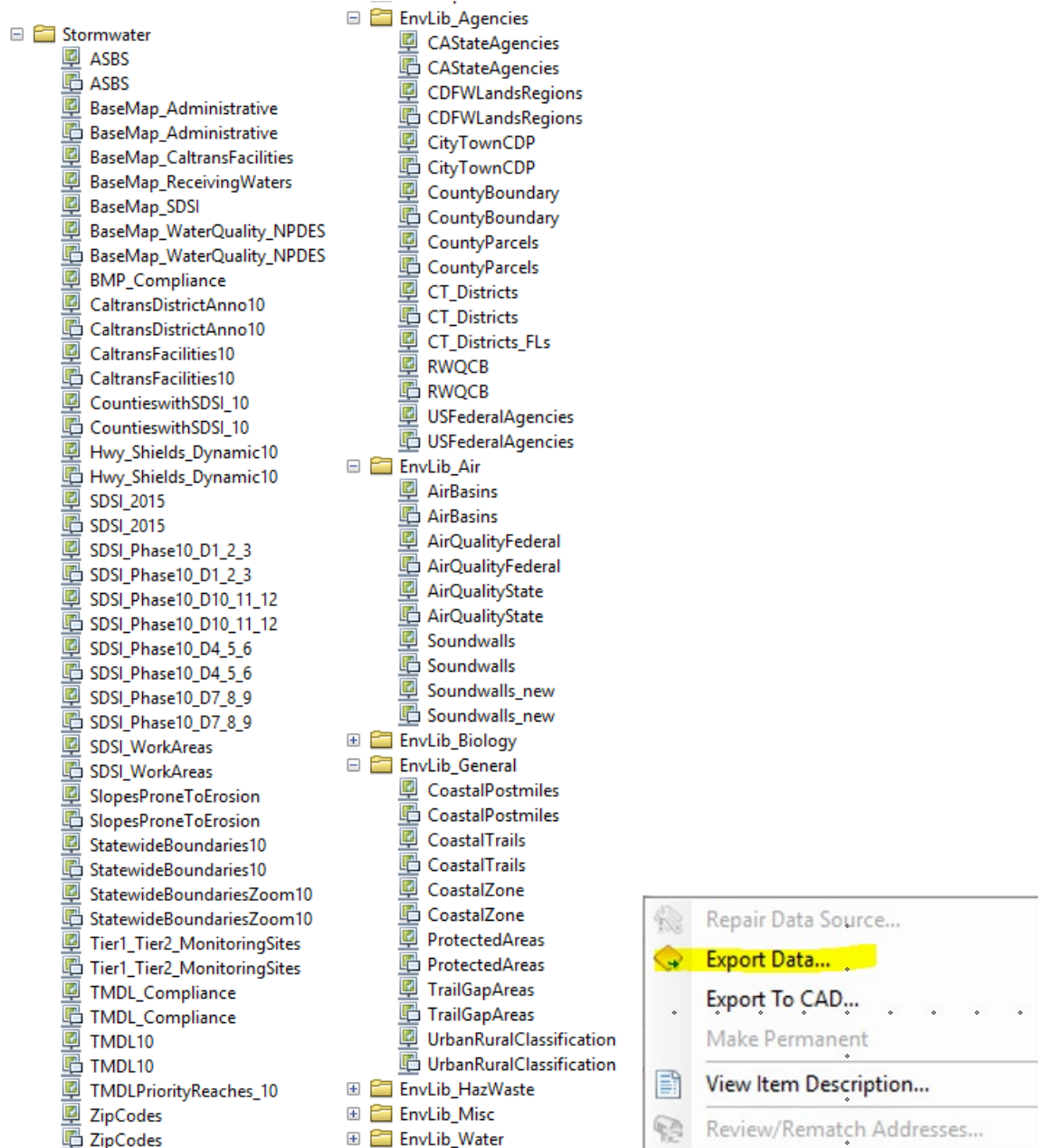


5. You can now navigate the folders of web services. To access “DEA GIS Library” layers go into the corresponding subjects under **EnvLib** folders, to access the “Stormwater” layers go under the **Stormwater** folder.



6. You will notice duplicate services with a different icon,  are Feature Services and can be exported as copies.

**Drag** any service with the icon above to the ArcMap **Table of Contents**. Right click any layer and go to “Data” then “Export Data”



7. You now have a copy of the web service layers. Keep in mind that there is no link between the exported layer and the live service. If you wish to have the most current version after updates. You must follow these steps again for the new service.
